The trustee board provides essential support and guidance to the Chief Executive, and up-to-date working knowledge of running charities is a crucial element in the mix.

Ideally, we are looking for a CEO of a medium to large national charity who has a personal interest in respiratory disease. Senior level experience of leading and managing a charitable organisation is essential, as is an interest in governance and a working knowledge of charity law and regulation. Knowledge of the healthcare environment would be an advantage.

The GPIAG, committed to achieving optimal respiratory health for all, is involved with policy and campaigning work as well as research and education of primary care health professionals. The trustees meet 2-3 times per year in London with occasional teleconferences as required plus regular email correspondence. The board currently consists of 2 lay and 2 medical trustees, and is likely to increase to 5- 6 trustees
